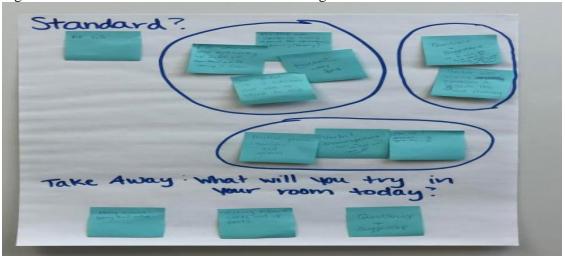
#### **Gorilla Learning Walks:**
