<p>High Risk Zone: ORANGE >75 cases/100K/14 days*</p> <p>Other considerations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Increasing trend in cases or hospitalizations • Test positivity >5% • Other health and education risks and benefits to children and their families 	<p>Strongly recommend distance learning with the option for limited in person learning in small groups, or cohorts, of students for the highest need students, such as students with disabilities, students living homeless, those farthest from educational justice, and younger learners.</p> <p>NOTE: If case counts continue to climb, the LCHD may impose a “Remote Only” directive with very limited in-person opportunities for at-risk students.</p>	<p><u>MONDAY-THURSDAY:</u></p> <p>AM GROUP: 8:00-10:30am PM GROUP: 12:15pm-2:45pm</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All kids PK-12 are able to be on-site at some point each day • Cohort groups of no more than 10* students with one staff member, no transitions to other groups • Students get individualized help and supports from staff helping work through K12/Fuel Education • Staff provides short activity/mask breaks outside as needed based on group needs each day • No class schedule, specials(PE, music, library/tech), or rotating classrooms • Grab & go lunch & breakfasts <p><u>FRIDAY:</u></p> <p>Distance Learning for ALL students</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teachers/staff check-in virtually or in-person with FULL online/at home students
<p>Moderate Risk Zone: YELLOW 25–75 cases/100K/14 days*</p> <p>Other considerations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Increasing trend in cases or hospitalizations • Test positivity >5% • Other health and education risks and benefits to children and their families 	<p>Recommend distance learning as described above. In addition, consider expanding in person learning to elementary students. Over time, consider adding hybrid in person learning for middle or high school students if limited COVID transmission occurs in schools.</p>	<p><u>MONDAY-THURSDAY:</u></p> <p>ALL STUDENTS PK-6 8:00am-12:00pm</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All kids PK-6 onsite each day • Elementary Schedule: Classes stay in cohorts, activity/mask breaks, specialist schedule (PE, music, library/tech) condensed <p>Students Grades 7-12 onsite 2 days per week, ½ the total number of students each day</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Red, Red, White, White Schedule (reduced transitions) <p style="text-align: center;">OR</p> <p>Students Grades 7-12 onsite 4 days per week with all students if possible (We will work with Lincoln County Health.)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Red & White (reduced transitions) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Busses run normal routes • Students receive grab & go lunch before leaving school • Teachers & paras will check-in with FULL online/at home students Monday-Thursday afternoons <p><u>FRIDAY:</u></p> <p>Distance Learning for ALL students</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teachers/staff check-in virtually or in-person with FULL online/at home students • Opportunity for ALL students to receive additional in-person supports as needed by appointment
<p>Low Risk Zone: GREEN* <25 cases/100K/14 days</p>	<p>Encourage full-time in person learning for all elementary students and hybrid learning for middle and high school. Over time and if physical space allows, consider full time in person learning for middle and high school.</p>	<p><u>MONDAY-THURSDAY:</u></p> <p>ALL STUDENTS PK-12 8:00am-2:00pm</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All kids PK-12 onsite each day • MS/HS Schedule: Red, White (reduced transitions) • Elementary Schedule: Classes stay in cohorts. AM, Lunch & PM Recess/Activity Breaks, Specialist rotations (PE, music, library/tech) • Busses run normal routes • Paras will check-in with FULL online/at home students Monday-Thursday afternoons <p><u>FRIDAY:</u></p> <p>Distance Learning for ALL students</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teachers/staff check-in virtually or in-person with FULL online/at home students • Opportunity for ALL students to receive additional in-person supports as needed by appointment
